We work with the Oconomowoc High School Activities Director and the administration to provide additional coaches, programs, and equipment that would not otherwise be available within the current district budget (non-budgeted needs). We encourage our youth to participate in healthy sports activities, and we encourage spirit at Cooney sports events. For a mere \$10 per school year, parents and fans can become members of the OSBC and help fund our efforts.

Our Biggest Endeavor Yet

The NEW Roundy's Physical Development Center

This 5,000 square foot, free-standing facility was designed and constructed at cost by Oliver Construction on OHS grounds for the use of all area students. This facility was provided to the school system in 2004 at no cost and was financed through donations from grants, endowments, and private and corporate sponsorships.

Our History & Structure

This organization began in 1972 with a small group of football fans banding together to give support to the football team. The very first donation was the flagpole and flag that flies over the stadium at the high school. Over the course of 30+ years, the organization has grown to over 350 members who give support to 21 girls' and boys' sports programs at OHS. The Booster Club has donated over \$160,000 to the athletic programs in the Oconomowoc Area School District during the past five years in addition to over \$300,000 in actual facilities.

We are a tax-exempt, non-profit organization governed by a set of by-laws. Our Board of Directors consists of 21 members. We have four standing committees: Audit, Budget, Membership, and Nominating. We also have special committees: Medals, Concessions, Golf Outing, Historian, Homecoming Float, Team Reps., Sports Program Guide, Gold Card, Tailgate, and 3-on-3 Basketball Tourney. Meetings are held monthly at the high school and all members are encouraged to attend. The Annual/General Meeting, where board member elections for the next school year are conducted, is held in May of each year.

OUR MEMBERSHIP

Volunteers make up our entire membership. Directors are elected for two-year terms and officers serve for one-year terms. All Board members are expected to chair committees during their term and to help at all activities. All members at large are encouraged to get involved wherever their interest lies. This could be a short-term, one time project or a year-long committee. We are always looking for new people to get involved. Though our volunteers are usually parents of student athletes at OHS, we welcome any adult who wants to come aboard and subscribe to our club's mission and purpose.
